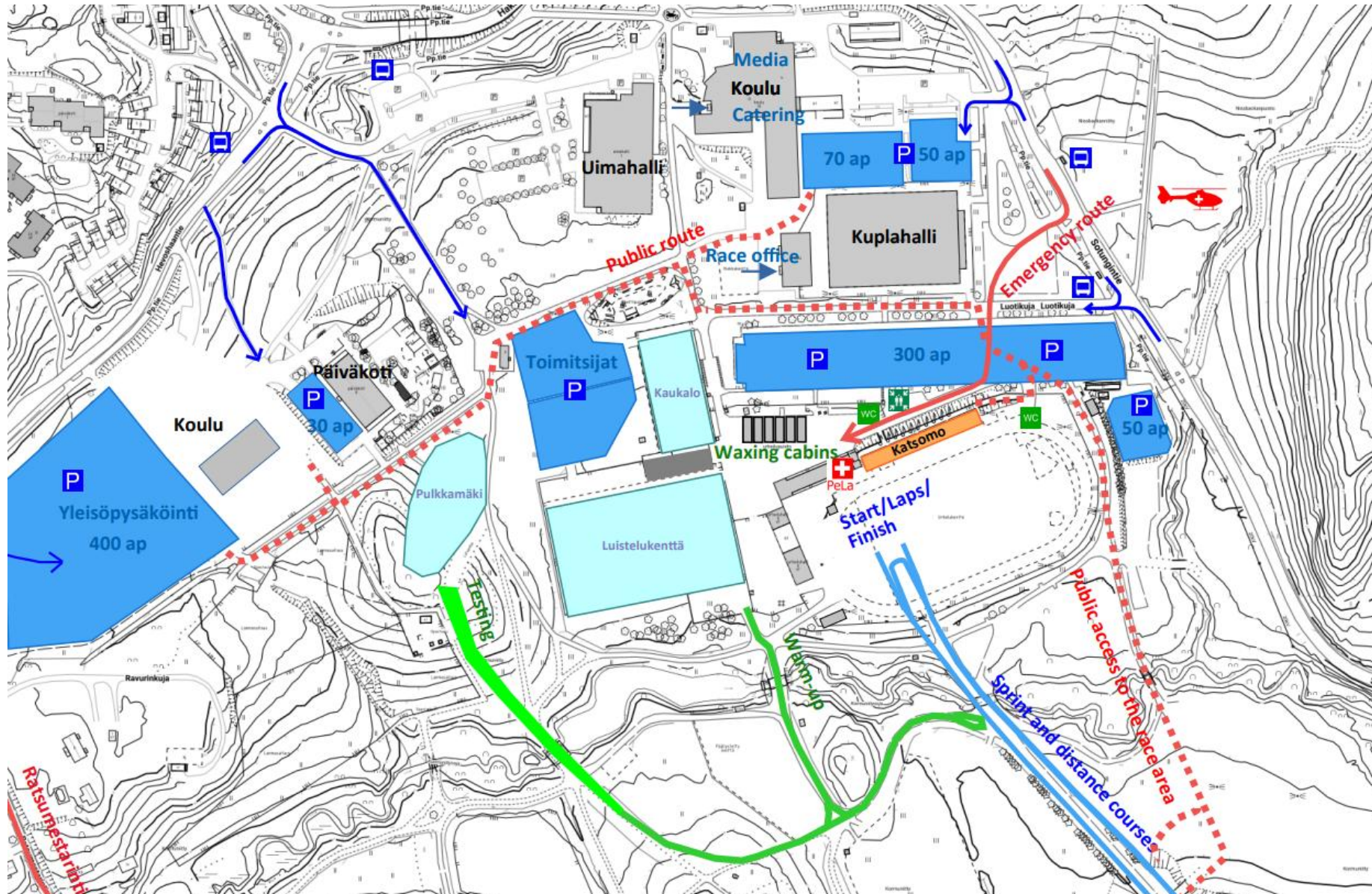

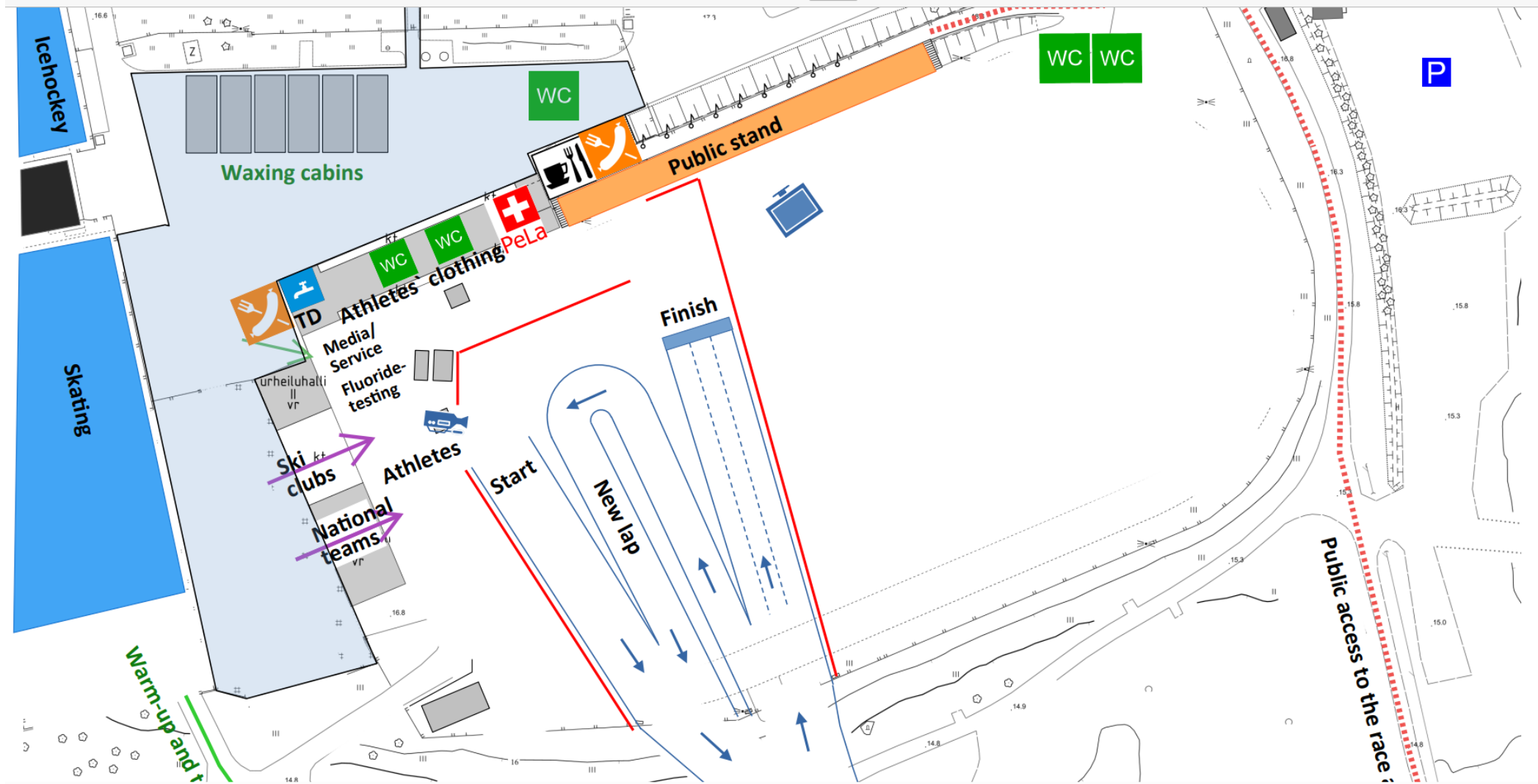

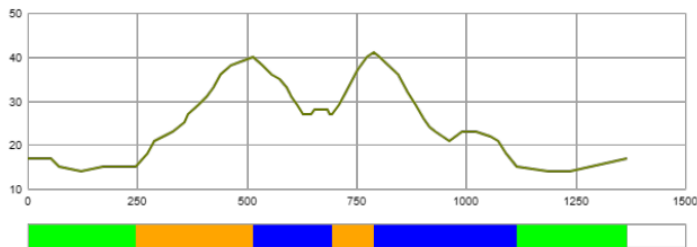

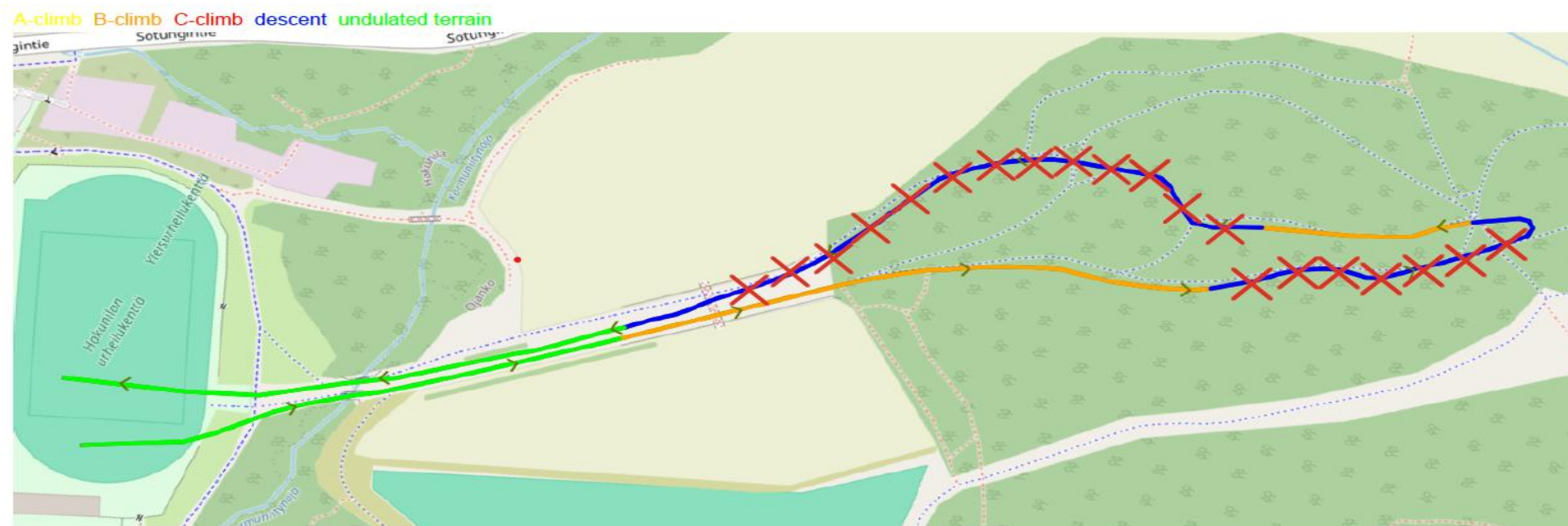


A-climb B-climb C-climb descent undulating terrain

* In competitions when the heats are not timed, the 6th positions in the semi-final heats are assigned from the 3rd ranked competitors in all the quarter final heats. The 3rd ranked competitor with the fastest qualifying time (Q R3-1) is assigned to the second semi-final heat S2 and the 3rd ranked competitor with the second best qualifying time (Q R3-2) is assigned to semi-final heat S1.

Mark your skis with startnumber and W/M! You can use FIS and/or Suomen Cup sticker from earlier races. You can get new white stickers from race office. Please, clean earlier numbers from skis!

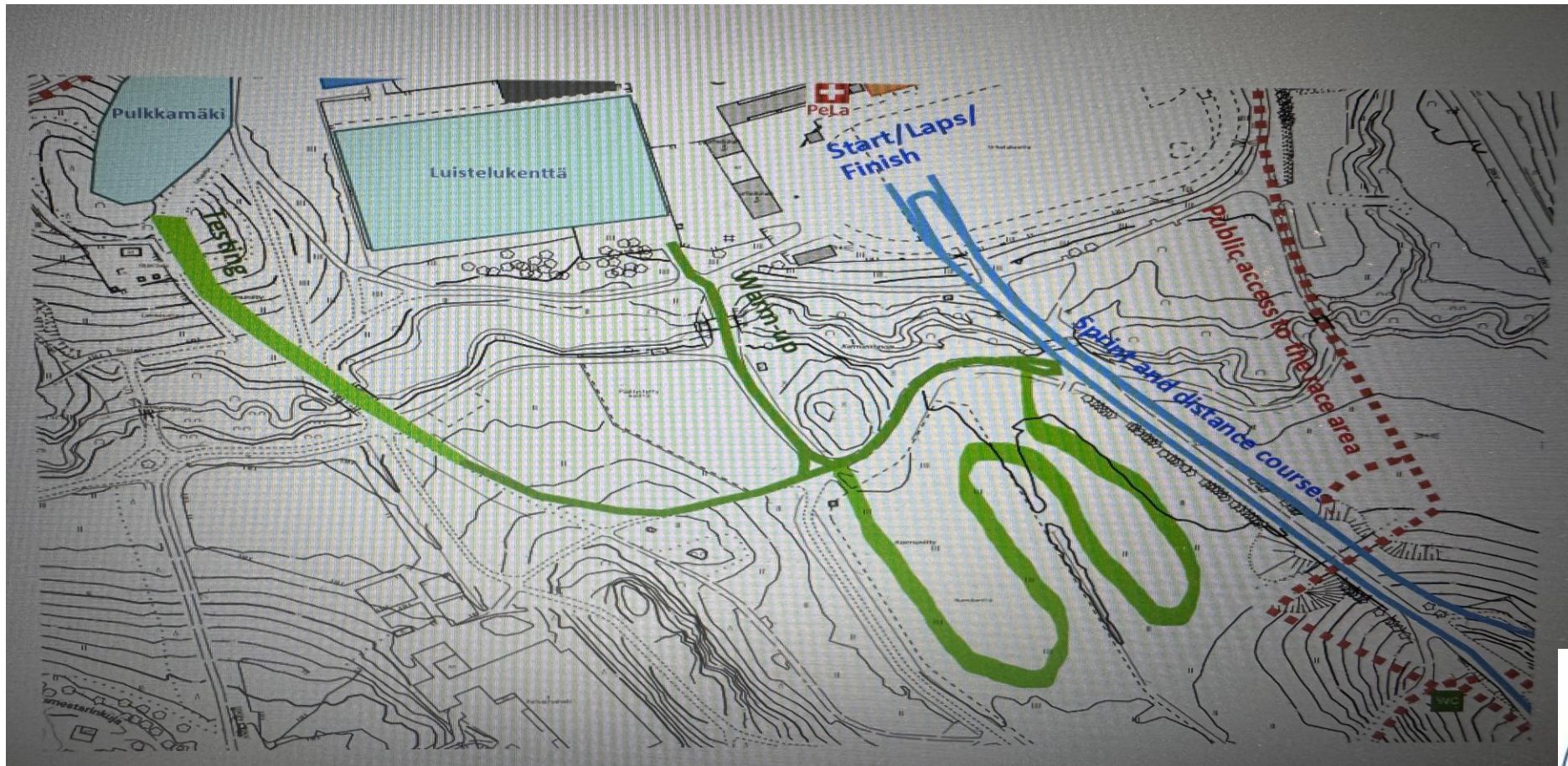
- Athletes can use one pair of skis during finals. It`s not allowed to change the skis between heats.
- There will be possibility to fix the grip wax between heats, in controlled area nearby the start – finish area. It`s not allowed to do anything for glide zones.
- Skis will collect by organisers after the finish the heats.
- Those which not qualified, skis will test immediately and picked up nearby fluortest white tent

Top 30 athletes will pick up their bibs and transponders before heats from the race office.

Transponders must be worn on both legs.

Leg bibs must be worn on the right leg.

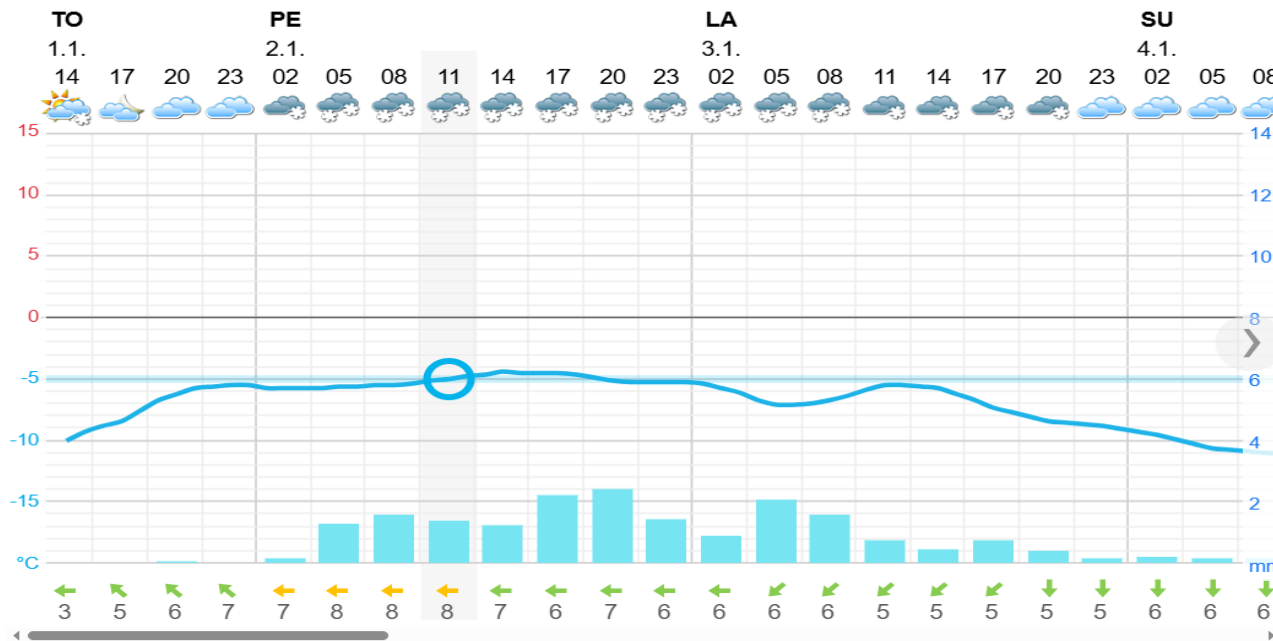

Race course closed 21:00-07:00

Grooming will be done to night if snowfall will be late. Otherwise regrooming about 05:00.

If we need to prepare the course due to heavy snowfall between the qualification and finals Jury will make a decision and will let you know. We will use snow patrol / forerunners to keep tracks in condition.
